# About This Car

2007 Porsche GT3 (997.1) Low mileage and zero over-revs!

26,904 miles. Clean title. Well maintained, needs nothing. I am selling the car because my wife and I are resetting our car-quiver and we need to make space. If I had a bigger garage, this car would be a long-term keeper. I have owned the car for two years, and used it around town as well as for DE / lapping events. Car has been driven with respect – as evidenced by zero over-revs!

Bi-Xenon headlights. Sunroof. Alcantara steering wheel. My understanding of the history is that the car was set up by the original owner at GMG Motorsports, in California. This car is equipped as follows:

- Set up to emulate the European Clubsport model: half cage, Euro-996 Porsche-Recaro leather bucket seats, and Schroth six-point harnesses (2024 date)
- Coolant lines welded
- Stock suspension adjusted to slightly lowered height
- 19" GMG wheels
- Rennline short shifter
- K&N intake (with washable reusable oil-style air filter)
- Fabspeed headers with high flow cats, GMG center muffler delete, stock side mufflers
- Guard limited slip differential (LSD) 'club' model (2020)

Paint is in excellent condition, and has clear wrap over front end and other key surfaces. A few blemishes to the clear wrap include that it has slightly yellowed on the front fenders, and there a few black scuffs on the clear bra below the door threshold, as visible in the photos. The car has Brembo steel rotors. New brake pads on all 4 corners, new rotors on front. New replacement Brembo rear rotors are in a box. The original PCCB rotors were functional when removed and are included, but I do not know what is their level of wear. Michelin Pilot Sport Cup 2 tires 50% life remaining.

Recent maintenance was done to ensure the car is 100%, including:

- Spark plugs and coils
- Oil/filter
- Brake caliper reseal
- New windshield

Also have a set of 18" Forgeline wheels for \$3,000, if you are interested.
