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Part 8 – Other Appointments and Committees

I.8.10 Autocross Chair

The Autocross ("AX") Chair, with the assistance of the committee members, disseminates Autocross Minimum Standards to the Regions. The AX Committee gathers information and lessons learned from Region Autocross programs and uses this information to create minimum standards and common practices for all Autocross events.

Procedures:

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

National Administrative

- Review all AX Program Incident and Observer Reports to ensure compliance with program standards
- o Review Incident Reports and any other communication from PCA members
- Attend the Winter National Staff Assembly, the Annual Summer Membership Meeting and the Board of Directors teleconference meetings
- o Submit quarterly reports on activities from the preceding quarter
- o Submit an annual budget

AX Committee

- Consists of a Chair and up to 7 committee members all who are appointed by the Executive Council (EC)
- Responsible for the development of the Autocross Minimum Standards, upon which a Region can build an autocross program. These standards are reviewed and updated by the Committee when appropriate. All revisions must receive approval from the EC prior to posting on pca.org or distribution to the membership.
- o Responsible for updating the AX Minimum Standards Safety Inspection Form.
