



Milestones in PCA Growth

1955

First gathering of United States Porsche enthusiasts was at founder Bill Sholar's home in the Washington D.C. area on February 8, 1955

First business meeting of the new organization, The Porsche Club of America, occurred at Blackie's Grille on September 13, 1955

Twelve prospective members attended the first business meeting at which Sholar was elected President

The 190 people who joined by January 31, 1956 were designated as **Charter Members** of the Porsche Club of America

1968

By the end of 1968, there were **over 5,000 members**

1973

Increasing by the end of 1973 to **over 10,000 members**

1984

Only 11 years later, PCA had grown to **over 20,000 members**

1992

In 1992 another milestone was reached when PCA had grown to **over 30,000 members**

1997

By 1997 PCA announced the membership had grown to **over 40,000 members**

2000

The end of the year 2000 showed the membership **over 50,000**

2011

60,000 members

2015

We ended 2014 with **68,000 members** forming the PCA family
